



Come Race The JBC 24 Hour Endurance Race!



John Burr Cycles and the Prairie Dogs MC will be taking over Glen Helen Raceway on **October 11-12** for the annual 24 Hours of Glen Helen. This year's event promises to be one of the best ever, looking to surpass the outstanding event of 2013. Winning once again last year was the JCR (Johnny Campbell Racing) Honda team of Colton Udall, Ryan Dudak, Timmy Weigand and David Camo. The JCR team was pushed to the limit (in fact had to come from behind to win) by the Precision Concepts team of Robbie Bell, Chris Hollis, Justin Seeds and Ty Renshaw. The starting leaders of the race, the Zip-Ty/Bonanza team of Mike Brown, Gary Sutherlin, Ty

Davis and Bobby Garrison, had some fuel delivery issues early on, gave up the lead, and were unable to recover. What a 24-hours it was!

Entries for this year's event are open and available online at glenhelen.com. **Gates open Friday, October 10th from 12pm to 10pm for overnight camping.** (We encourage early arrival for great pit locations!). This is a fantastic family/friends event that will provide a weekend of camaraderie, racing, and fun! **Gates open Saturday at 6am**, and stay open for the duration of the event. **Gate fees are \$20 per adult for the weekend; kids 6-12 are \$10. Camping is \$10.**

The following classes will be included in the JBC 24 Hours of Glen Helen:

Entry fees are \$400 per team (each team has 6 riders!) **Iron-Man entries are \$150.** You can sign up at the same location as check-in Saturday morning—the Glen Helen Main Track Tower. **Check in/ post entries open at 6:30am.** The green flag will drop for the 24-Hours at 10am, with the checkered flag falling on Sunday morning, also at 10am!

Nuts and Bolts for the John Burr 24 Hours of Glen Helen: Much of this event will follow the same regulations as the 6 and 10 Hour JBC Endurance Events. For those of you who have not ridden the JBC events in the past, this summary will give you all the information you need:

PITS & BIKE EXCHANGE:

- Located in Amateur Pit area. Impound is located at the Next to REM Tower.
- Scoring will be at the REM tower.
- You are allowed what will fit in your assigned pit location –The pits will have plenty of room for all team members.
- **YOU MUST ONLY USE THE ALLOWED AREA.** You may camp in your the pit area.
- You will be assigned a pit area at time of sign up.
- Riders may pit or change riders at any time.
- You must work on bikes at your pit location.
- **SPEED LIMIT MANDATORY at 5 MPH IN PITS.** If you exceed the speed limit you may be disqualified.
- **WE RACE AT NIGHT EVERYONE MUST HAVE HEADLIGHTS*******

IMPOUND:

- All Amateur Teams may use 2 bikes and 6 Riders– one bike remains in the impound at all times.

- PRO TEAMS: One (1) Bike and 4 Riders. \$5000 Purse: \$2500 1st - \$1500 2nd - \$1000 3rd
- ALL TEAMS MUST HAVE SAME TEAM NUMBER ON BOTH BIKES. FRONT & LEFT AT THE VERY LEAST!
- One bike must be in the impound at all times. (If two bikes are being used)
- Transponders are on the bike- each time you switch bikes move the transponder to the new bike.
- You and your team may **not work** on the bike in the impound area.

WATER AND TRACK

- We will have water trucks throughout the race track watering.
- If you see a quad with a yellow flag waving, the water truck is ahead. Please proceed with caution.
- The course consists of several different terrains, etc. Please be careful the first lap to learn the track. ***DO NOT CUT THE COURSE! WE HAVE A NEW TRANSPONDER SYSTEM THAT WILL BE USED TO CATCH COURSE CUTTING. STAY ON THE COURSE!**

PENALTIES:

****Any Penalties will be access during the race which include cutting the course, speeding through pits, working on your bike in the impound, etc. The course referee will access a time for the penalty and you be held in the pits for the amount time access. The course referee will DQ TEAM and/or access a time for the penalty and you be held in the pits for the amount of time accessed.**

This Event will follow D37 and AMA rules.

****Protest from teams must be done by rider of record within 30 minutes after the results are posted. Promoter has 24 hours to get results back to you on the protest.**

SCORING AND REGISTRATION:

- All Riders must register at Sign-Ups located at the National Tower.
- Sign-Ups are open 2pm-6pm Friday, Oct 10th & reopens 7:30am on Saturday, October 11th.
- Transponders will be used – You **MUST** leave a CC or DL for deposit-No CHARGE FOR THE TRANSPONDER.
- TRANSPONDERS will be mounted on your bike!
- Computer scoring is used. We will try to have the results within an hour after the race. 25% Trophies will be mail to you 3 weeks after the event.
- There will be live scoring on line at www.glenhelen.com There will be a TV screen located at the registration tower...

Entries are open, we encourage you to get your team together now for one of the most fun events of the year! Camping, hanging out with your family and friends, rooting on your favorite teams and riders throughout the 24-hour race duration, and racing the 24 hours is a unique experience that presents itself only once per year! We hope to see everyone there!
