



## Come Race Round 2 of the JBC Endurance Series!



The second round of the John Burr Cycles Endurance Series is fast approaching! If you have not yet done so, it is time to get those entries in! Online entries continue to be open through June 27th [here](#). The 10-Hour Endurance Race is set to be flagged off on **Saturday**, June 28th at 8am and will be ending at 6pm. Get your teams together and plan on running fast for ten hours!

The JBC Endurance has trophies and awards for both individual (10-Hour and 24-Hour) events as well as trophies and awards for the series winners. Plan on racing the two remaining races of the John Burr Cycles Endurance Series events to grab your share of the prizes!

Teams are comprised of up to four riders who can utilize up to two bikes (one must stay in the impound area at all times); there is also an Ironman Class whose riders can also use two machines. **Entry fees for the Teams** are \$190 pre-entry and \$200 post-entry; **Ironman Class entries** are \$90 pre and \$100 post. Save \$20 by signing up early at [glenhelen.com](http://glenhelen.com). In addition to the online entries, teams and Ironmen can enter at the track on Friday between 2pm and 6pm, and on race-day (Saturday) at 6 am. Signup location is the REM Tower. There are no

membership fees required!

The race will be run over an 8-mile course designed (and tested) by both 4-time National Champ Gary Jones and current Dirt Bike Editor Ron Lawson. It will appeal to riders of all ability levels, with the green flag dropping at 8am Sunday morning and the checkers falling for the lead rider at 6pm that afternoon.

This is a great family and friends weekend! We encourage everyone to come on out early Friday to get the best camping/pit locations. Plan on spending the weekend relaxing at your campsite, and on Saturday racing the 6-hour or cheering on your favorite rider or riders! There are no camping fees for the JBC Endurance events. Spectator fees for Saturday are \$10 for Adults and \$5 for kids. The Ten-Hours, as always, is a great spectator event whether you man the pits, check out the race from the Glen Helen bleachers, or walk the track to watch your riders conquer the Glen Helen obstacles!
